Non-native English speakers must demonstrate language proficiency (e.g., IELTS 7.0, TOEFL iBT 94-101, CEFR C1). Cultural familiarity with Thai work settings and a willingness to support Thai staff are valued. Prior teaching, particularly in a university context, is advantageous.
